

Announcement of Roundtable meetings on REMIT implementation

Ljubljana, 12 July 2013

Subject: Invitation to participate in the Agency's REMIT implementation roundtables

Dear Sir/Madam,

In connection with the implementation of Regulation (EU) No 1227/2011 (REMIT), the Agency for the Cooperation of Energy Regulators will organise roundtable meetings with interested stakeholders on the REMIT implementation in Ljubljana as of September 2013. The purpose of the roundtables is to listen to the views of, and obtain information from, interested stakeholders and invite attendees to comment on selected questions on data collection under REMIT, on which we believe further consideration would be useful. The roundtables will be arranged separately for the following stakeholder groups:

- Energy exchanges;
- Trade reporting systems, trade matching systems or other persons professionally arranging transactions;
- Trade repositories aiming at being registered or recognised under applicable Union legislation on derivative transactions, central counterparties and trade repositories;
- Transmission System Operators;
- Associations of market participants;
- Service Providers for the dissemination of inside information.

Further roundtables for additional stakeholder groups will be considered as and when needed. The roundtables will be held in Ljubljana. In order to decide on the exact organisation of the roundtables and their dates, stakeholders are invited to register their interest to participate in the roundtables by 25 July 2013, by 12.00 noon, Central European Time, i.e. two weeks after publication of this Open Letter on the Agency's website, by sending their application to the following mailbox: remit.roundtable@acer.europa.eu. Applications received after this deadline may not be considered.

The roundtable meetings can accommodate a limited number of participants. Depending on the number of responses received, ACER may, or may not, be able to accommodate all requests to participate in the roundtable. In the interest of admitting as many interested parties as possible, and representing a wide variety of stakeholders, only one participant per organisation is normally permitted at the roundtable. Further information about the dates, draft agendas and more details will be sent to registered participants in due course, i.e. within 10 working days following their registration.
