- By December 2013 first outline of draft of GTM review and update
- Early 2014 Green Paper “Building on the past, a bridge to the future”
- By May 2014 final draft GTM proposal
- In June-July 2014 finalisation and publication of the updated GTM


GTM stakeholder workshops
