How can I reach CEER Premises?

The office is located approximately 2 minutes' walk from metro station Merode.

From the metro station Merode take Exit Avenue des Celtes. Cross Avenue des Celtes (with your back to the Arch), continue straight ahead and then turn right into Rue Père de Deken.
