XBID solution procurement status & Implications (1)

- Following an extensive XBID evaluation process, a unanimous decision could not be reached among the PXs on the preferred offer for the SOB/CMM system:
 - 3 PXs indicated their preference for one system, 1 indicated its preference for the other system, and another PX did not express a clear-cut preference
 - Individual PXs assessments have been submitted to ACER, and PXs requested ACER for an Opinion on the Service Provider to be selected, fully in accordance with EU XBID Procurement Agreement
- On June the 17th, ACER released its final *Informal Opinion* on the preferred system provider for the SOB/CMM to be used for the implementation of the XBID Target Model in Europe











- In conformity with the EU XBID Procurement Agreement signed by all involved PXs, APX/Belpex, EPEX SPOT, Nord Pool Spot, OMIE and OTE commit to start contract negotiation with the selected vendor
- PXs are committed in case of successful completion of negotiation and, following contractual agreement with the vendor, to start services subject to:
 - receiving reassurance on cost recovery by the concerned parties
 - finalize the PX Intraday Cooperation Agreement setting the cooperation terms between PXs

XBID solution procurement status & Implications (2)

To meet the challenging objectives set by the Authorities, PXs focus now on exclusive negotiations with the selected vendor, and on planning a deliverables-oriented, yet sustainable, project structure for the implementation of the EU XBID solution



The project is open to any PX willing to join PX Cooperation Agreement



Co-existence of regions and isolated areas is supported by the solution







Coming focus areas

- Finalisation of the PX Cooperation Agreement
- Start of contractual negotiations with the vendor:
 - Negotiation of key terms
 - Potential Letter of Intent to enable to start the work
 - to be further ellaborated with relevant parties
- Budget & Cost-recovery agreement:
 - Definition of general cost recovery scheme with the TSOs & NRAs
 - Estimation of the project budget (pre-requisite to obtain cost recovery assurance)
