

## **UPDATE - LATVIA**

- GDP 2012 versus 2011 increase by 5.6%
- Electricity consumption:
  - 2011 versus 2010 decrease by 1.9%
  - 2012 versus 2011 increase by 4.8%
- Gas consumption:
  - 2010 versus 2009 increase by 19.3%\*
  - 2011 versus 2010 decrease by 11.9%
  - 2012 versus 2011 decrease by 6.3%

\* impact of cold winter





#### Dynamics of energy resource prices

- From 1st January 2012 registration of power and heat generation plants and traders has replaced the former licensing procedure
- Draft of Electricity market law under discussion in Parliament commission net metering
- Draft of Electricity market law was under discussion in Government – full market opening, REMIT requirements on imposing of sanctions
- Hot debate is taking place about elimination of support to the power production from renewable sources and gas in CHP



- All customers are free to choose their supplier from 2007.
- Real market opening took place in 2009. All customers with fuses above 100A became market participants.
- From April 1, 2012 additional 5000 electricity customers became market participants.
- Further market opening took place from November 1, 2012.



- In March 2012 the Regulator has adopted standard agreements for licensees of distribution services
- Revised standard contract for customers
- Introduced institution of Last Resort supplier
- Several meetings were held by the recently established Power Market Board
- Initial plan of MoE was full market opening from September 1, 2013, now postponed

# TSO unbundling / certification - 1

- Latvia has chosen the unbundling model of independent system operator (ISO)
- New company "Latvijas elektriskie tīkli" (LET) owner of transmission assets - has been established in April 4, 2011
- The final decision on transfer of ownership rights of ISO - JSC "Augstsprieguma tīkls" - has been taken in January 2012
- At present the owner of ISO is the Ministry of Finance of Republic of Latvia
- In May 2012 ISO has submitted an application for certification to Regulator



- The Regulator has issued respective provisions with regard to the ISO certification
- Intensive consultations on certification were carried out during summer 2012 with stakeholders: ISO, LET, ministry, EC
- The formal opinion of the EC on draft decision on ISO certification, issued in December 3, 2012, in general was positive
- At the end of January 2013 the Regulator has adopted a final decision on ISO certification and sent the notification to EC
- In April 2013 ISO has submitted a plan demonstrating an intention to fulfill the requirements of certification decision



- In August 2012 the Regulator has adopted TSO's 10 year network development plan (TYNDP) with conditionality
- In April 2013 TSO has submitted for informal consultations a draft cost benefit analysis of 3rd LAT – EST interconnection
- After clarification the cost benefit analysis will be presented to the Board of Regulator
- TSO is in the process of making changes to TYNDP



- From April 1, 2012 new transmission tariffs are in force with average increase of ~ 21% (average transmission tariff 11,5 EUR/MWh)
- Gas tariffs are in line with prices of oil/oil products in the world markets small decrease of natural gas price from January 1, 2013 (~2%)
- Set up of heat tariffs depends on the fluctuation of price of gas or wood chips (50 80 EUR/MWh)
- From April 1, 2013 a sharp increase of generation support fee

Future activities and challenges

- Expecting repeated review by administrative court of decision on electricity end user tariffs from April 2011
- Supervision of implementation by TSO of certification decision
- Adoption of amendments to TSO's TYNDP
- Opening of Nord Pool Spot bidding zone in Latvia
- Participation in drafting of legislative acts for 100% electricity market opening
- Expected changes in the Grid Code under discussion
