Focus for all GRIPs

- Build on the current GRIP and improve it
- Improve stakeholder communication/consultation
- Describe/explain the Region's assets & needs
- Explain why investments in gas transmission projects are required in Region
- Describe projects

NW GRIP 2013: Specific Focus

- Improvements based on feedback received, including RCC recommendations
- Enhancing regional supply and demand analysis
- Showing the Impact of projects on cross border points
- Show procedure and results of regional cross border open seasons / auctions
- 'Deep Dive' into regional congested points as highlighted by TYNDP 2013-2022




Chapter: Zoom in on TYNDP results for NW region
