1 Opening

The meeting was opened by the chair who welcomed the Experts. The chair reminded the Experts of the importance of their contribution and the expectations toward the Expert Group. He explained that the Agency strives to create an open atmosphere for discussion whilst fully maintaining confidentiality.

2 Recent Issues

The chair gave an update on recent developments in REMIT implementation since the entry into force of Commission Implementing Regulation (EU) No 1348/2014, the REMIT implementing acts, on 7 January 2015.

3 Compliance with the data collection obligation under the REMIT implementing acts

The experts were invited to discuss REMIT-related Q&As, in particular concerning questions relating to the notion of "single consumption unit" and with regard to the reporting of LNG contracts. It was agreed to continue discussions in the next expert group meeting. A presentation on REMIT Trade Data Reporting Agreements, an initiative from EFET, was provided and discussed. The chair welcomed initiatives for standard data reporting agreements for European market participants with organised market places, especially if they are RRM neutral and comply with the requirements of competition law.

4 Compliance with the disclosure of inside information obligation, in particular in view of the REMIT implementing acts

The chair briefly informed about the public consultation on disclosure of inside information (PC_2015_R_03).

5 Interaction with the implementation of EU financial market legislation

The group discussed recent developments in EU financial market legislation, in particular with regard to MiFID II/MiFIR, EMIR and MAR, and their potential interaction with REMIT.
