1 Opening

2 Recent Issues

The chair gave an update on recent developments in REMIT implementation since the last expert group meeting.

3 Compliance with the data collection obligation under the REMIT implementing acts

The experts were invited to discuss REMIT-related Q&As, in particular concerning the following topics:

Discussion of Q&As: Relations between Market Participants, OMPs and RRMs;

The input received will be considered for future updates of the Agency's REMIT Q&A paper.

4 Compliance with the disclosure of inside information obligation, in particular in view of the REMIT implementing acts

The Agency provided the updates on reporting of inside information and specifically the units will be used for reporting unavailable capacities for gas facilities; multiple ownership of an asset and respective schema for the identification of market participants; disclose of inside information in case of an outage of a gas power plant which is operated to generate electricity.

5 Interaction with the implementation of EU financial market legislation

The group discussed recent developments in EU financial market legislation, in particular with regard to MiFID II/MiFIR, EMIR and MAR, and their potential interaction with REMIT.
