1. Opening

2. Recent issues

The chair provided an update on recent developments with regard to REMIT since the last Expert Group meeting.

3. Amendments to Chapter 7 of the ACER Guidance

The experts were invited to discuss the current practise of publication of inside information and potential means to improve this. Special attention were drawn to the question whether disclosure of inside information should take place on inside information platforms and feedback on the suggested draft guidance was gathered form the experts and the NRAs.

4. Disclosure of inside information and transparency: Public Consultation on implementing thresholds for the publication of II – draft presentation

ACER presented the Draft Public Consultation on thresholds for the publication of inside information to be published. The experts discussed the questions proposed in the draft document and provided their feedback.

5. Brexit

ACER presented the Infosheet prepared for the RRMs on the implications on the implementation of REMIT of the approaching withdrawal of the United Kingdom from the European Union for data reporting. The experts provided their feedback to the document and discussed other aspects relevant to REMIT implementation post-Brexit.

Article 3.4 (b) REMIT Exemption

ACER presented to the Expert Group the topic of exemption from the REMIT proviosion on the prohibition of insider trading, followed by a discussion with the participants.
